FAIRWORK COMMISSION DELIVERS A BLOW TO CLEANAWAY

Despite Cleanaway's best efforts to get info from a Transport Workers Union delegate about the post supporting waste workers, the commission has said NO, saying it didn't matter to the TWU's bargaining case.

The post thanked hard working waste workers like you for fighting against "Big Blue".

It said: "Big Blue is in panic mode as such they will do anything for this not to go to arbitration and now have their new Industrial Relations rep up from Melbourne visiting all of the yards to see what is needed to get these agreements over the line, they have been telling you for 6 months, but you choose not to listen, Big Blue."
